

In Face Up Pai Gow Poker a 52 card deck plus a joker is used. The dealer deals seven cards to the dealer and to all six player's spots — whether or not they are played. It plays like conventional Pai Gow Poker, except that the dealer cards are exposed first before the players set their hands. If the dealer has exactly an Ace-High Pai Gow hand, then all player hands will automatically result in a push (tie) regardless of the players' hand strength. Face-Up Pai Gow Poker is commission free.

An optional Ace-High Bonus wager is based on if the dealer's seven cards are an Ace-High Pai Gow hand. The payouts for the Ace-High Bonus Wager is as follows.

Dealer's Hand	Payout Odds
Dealer and Player Ace High	40 to 1
Dealer Ace High w/Joker	15 to 1
Dealer Ace High no Joker	5 to 1

Side wagers are prohibited.

FACE UP PAI GOW EXCEPTIONS TO FORTUNE PAI GOW PROGRESSIVE

- 1. The rules to Face Up Pai Gow are the same as Fortune Pai Gow Progressive except that:
 - A. The dealer's cards are exposed first.
 - B. If the dealer has exactly an Ace-High Pai Gow hand then all player hands will automatically result in a push (tie) regardless of the player hand strength.
 - C. Players do not pay commission on any winning hands.
 - D. Face Up Pai Gow offers an optional Ace-High Bonus wager.
